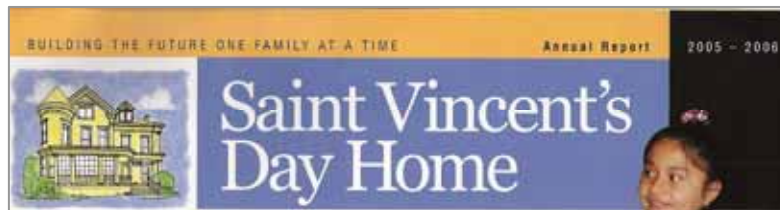


## Excerpt from Saint Vincent's Day Home 2005-2006 Annual Report

Some time ago, our Executive Director Corinne Mohrmann wrote a holiday letter to our friends and donors entitled "*The Miracle on Eighth Street.*" Over the years there have been many surprises, amazing happenings—and yes, miracles—that I have experienced at 1086 Eighth Street, two of which I'd like to share with you here.

Recently, I received a call from *The 1200 Foundation*, a non-profit committed to advancing the lives of the working poor by raising tax-deductible funds from individual and corporate donors.
